Policy for Safe Golf Procedures

The Association of Kent Veteran Golfers undertakes:

- a) to adopt and comply with all Safe Golf Procedures published by England Golf (<https://www.safegolf.org/index.html>) and required to be followed by the Safe Golf Accredited golf clubs which host our tournaments.
- b) to notify our members that the above policy is published and freely available on our association's website (www.akvg.com).

As a result of the covid-19 pandemic the UK Government introduced procedures designed to reduce the risk of exposing oneself and others to the virus.

England Golf publishes 'golf-specific' interpretations of the government's requirements. Inter alia these embrace:

- Self isolating after a positive covid test and/or when feeling unwell
- Booking in advance in order to participate
- Order of Play sheets naming all competitors
- Playing holes from the 1st or 10th tees in the correct order
- Social distancing, including taking care to avoid walkers on the course
- Mask wearing in the clubhouse and pro shop
- Not touching 'furniture' on the course (flagsticks, bunker rakes, ball washers etc)

During 2022 the government has progressively relaxed some of these requirements, or made them optional by personal choice. AKVG continues to support and comply with

the provisions and procedures promoted by  **SafeGolf**
