Our policy for avoiding slow play is 'Ready Golf':

1. Arrive at the venue in plenty of time
2. Be prepared to start your round on schedule
3. Don't wait until it's 'your turn' - play your next shot as soon as it is safe to do so
4. Play your own shot before helping to find another player's lost ball
5. Observe the 3-minute limit for looking for a lost ball
6. Pick up when you can't score
7. At each green, 'park up' ready for the next tee
8. Don't mark your card at the green – do it at the next tee
9. Keep up with the group ahead
10. If you fall back by a hole, let the group behind through.
