



AKVG: Scorecard Good Practice Guidelines

To make our Scorers' job as straightforward as possible, please:

- Exchange cards with your partner/opponent, fill in the card as you play, then return it with the Player's and Marker's names and signatures.
- Only record the named Player's score and the Marker's score on the card.
- As the Marker, complete the scorecard in the conventional way, using the 'Player 1' column to show gross strokes, and the 'Points' column to show the Stableford score for each hole.
- Put your own gross strokes and Stableford score in the 'Markers' column.

For the sake of clarity, an illustration for a **Singles** competition is offered below:
